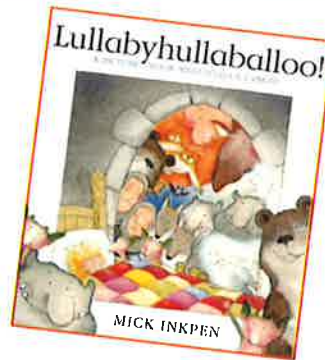

Stories we shall be sharing with the nursery this term...



This term our stories are all about light and dark. We'll be playing and learning using these books as a starting point. Read along with us at home! Most of these titles will be easily found at a local library.

## Learning at Home

**Reading together:** Sharing books with your child in English or your home language can be fun. Talking about the story and pictures is an important part of their reading and language development!

**Cook up a storm:** We all have to eat so why not let your little ones join in with food preparation. Use words like 'heavy', 'light', 'more' and 'less' when measuring and discuss your favourite tastes and textures.

**Little Helpers:** Children may not be as strong as adults; giving them small tasks around the house builds up important muscles and a sense of responsibility. It could help you out too!
