



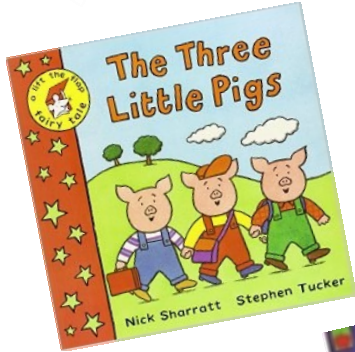

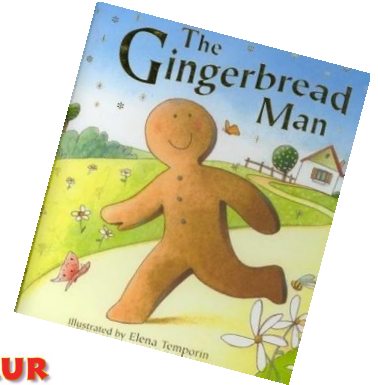

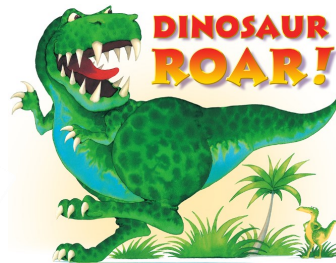
Reception Newsletter Summer Term 2

Literacy

As we are learning about dinosaurs, we will be looking at size and comparing long /short, big/ small. You should continue to talk to your child about money and the value of coins.

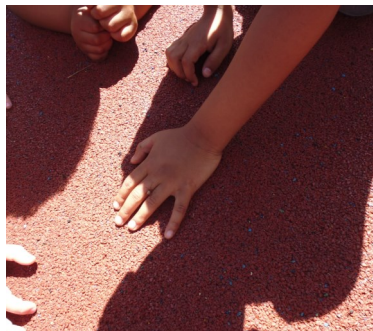
Personal, Social and Emotional Development.
