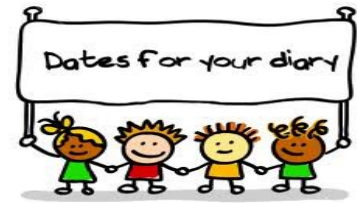


Black History/Cultural Heritage Week

Tuesday the 5th of November — Internet Safety Day more details to follow

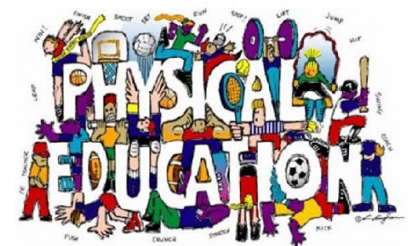
Thursday 21st of November - Parents Evening

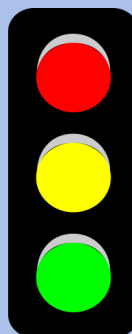
