

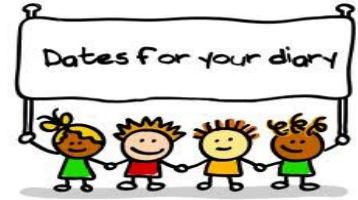
# Harvest Festival Assembly

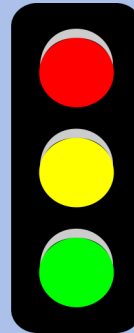
