



Eid Activities

- Make an Eid card for a family member or friend. Challenge yourself and make a pop up Eid card – you can google how to do this if you need help.
- Write an acrostic poem for Eid (acrostic poem is a poem where the first letter of each line spells out a specific word)
- Research how other Muslims celebrate Eid around the world. What similarities did you find? Draw/write about other festivals people celebrate, how do they celebrate them
- Make hand print and write down the 5 pillars of Islam on each finger.
- Make a recipe book. You can include the recipes of your favourite meals that were cooked for Eid.
- Make a poster for Eid to hang up in your room. You can include who celebrates Eid, how Eid is celebrated and why people celebrate Eid.
- Paint/draw a mosque and collage it using lentils, rice or tissue paper. This is your chance to show how creative you can be!
- Make fruit kebabs for your family, you can use banana, apples, strawberries and grapes
- Bake and decorate cupcakes
- Make bracelets and necklaces using beads or even pasta! You can give them as presents to your family.
- Choose a few things from your room that you no longer need or use to donate to charity.
